

Meadows Mill



Burnley Road was also home to Meadows Mill, driven by a water wheel, the mill had been in existence since 1789. A multi-storey building was erected in 1860, being sold shortly afterwards to the then owner of Olive Mill, who added a weaving shed, parts of which can still be seen today.

In 1946 the mill was suddenly closed and the machinery sold off to Syria. The mill became derelict during the 1960s and was demolished in 1970; the remaining buildings and new addition are today used by Glen Castings and Halliday Health Care respectively.
